

YOUR RIGHT TO CLEAN WATER, CLEAN AIR & CLEAN LAND

If you have a concern about these rights, or about protecting your health or the environment, you may want to contact an experienced lawyer to assist you with the process shown in the example below:



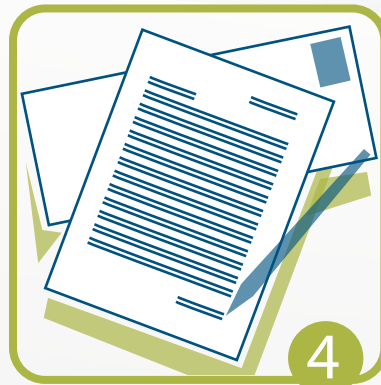
If you see, smell or feel pollution that concerns you...



Identify the pollution source as best you can.



Tell your local or state agency of your concern.



Have an attorney assist you with a notice letter to the source.



If the problem continues or goes unaddressed for 60-90 days...



You can file a "Citizen Suit" to stop the pollution.

If the cost of an attorney makes you hesitant to pursue action, consider that all federal environmental laws have "polluter pays" provisions authorizing payment of your legal fees and expenses, if you prevail.
